PSSA District Sports Trial Results

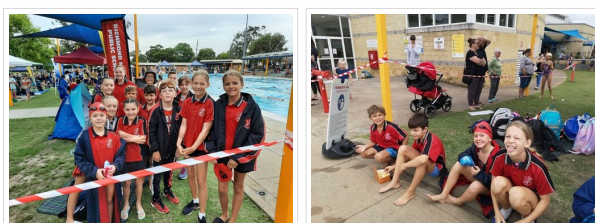

PSSA Trials

PSSA Trials notes for some particular sports are starting to be handed out to the students that are interested. Please be sure to get Mr Thurling or the Sports Co-ordinator to sign the notes prior to taking the note on the day to hand to the Coach/Sports Convener. Without this permission note your child may not be able to trial on the day.

How it works:

The schools in our Hawkesbury District inform the students of the trials available to them by a note in Term 1. A number of our local teachers are assigned a particular sport and run the trials selecting students from our local public schools to form a Hawkesbury Team to represent our District at the Sydney West Competitions in each particular sport.

What it involves:

The students' parents are responsible for taking them to and from trials (can be up to 3 trials) in after school hours where they will meet the coach of that team. If the student is selected for the District Team in a particular sport, parents are responsible for their child on competition days (along with the coach assigned to that sport) and also for travel to and from the events which are held in school time. A representative from Sydney West PSSA will be present at these competition days and will then select from all the students competing on that day to form a Regional Team to represent Sydney West at the State Championships.

Great Opportunity:

It is a great opportunity for our students to give it a go and possibly get selected to not only represent themselves, Richmond North PS, the Hawkesbury but even maybe their Region and State.

What to do next:

If your child is in Yr5 or Yr6, feel they are skilled in one of these sports and would like to try out for this team/individual sport the school will be handing out the notes in the first month of school to any student that is interested. Please see Mrs Wilkins if you have any questions.

- Tuesday 2-2:30pm with K-2

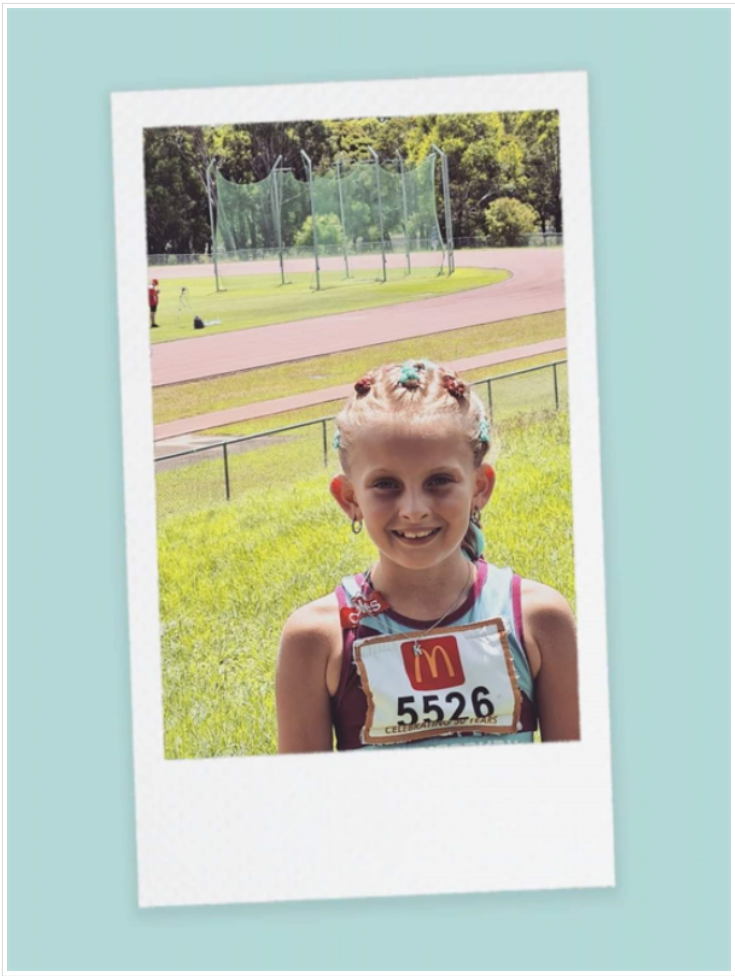
Before every broadcast we start with easy listening music while we check the system. 2pm is when you will start hearing us live.
